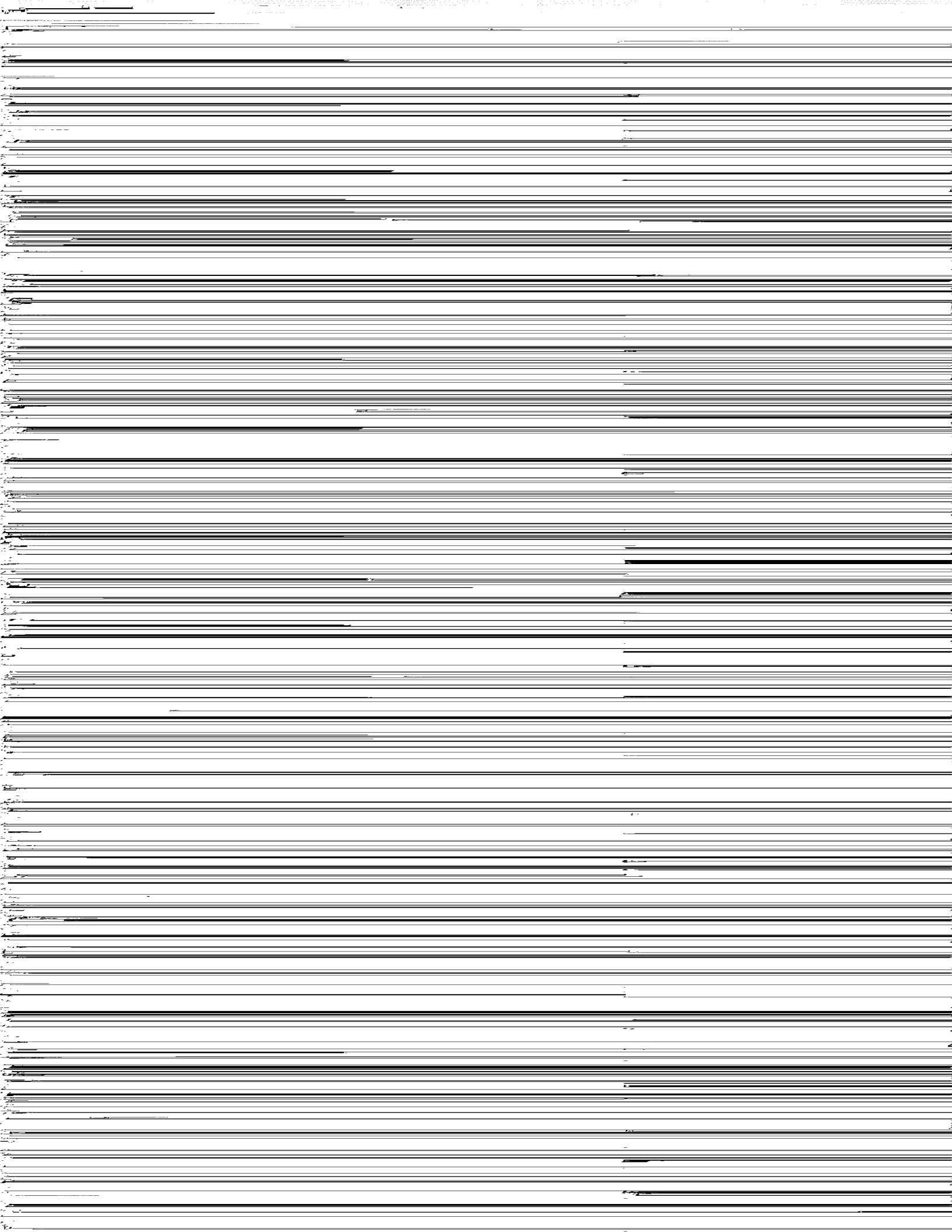
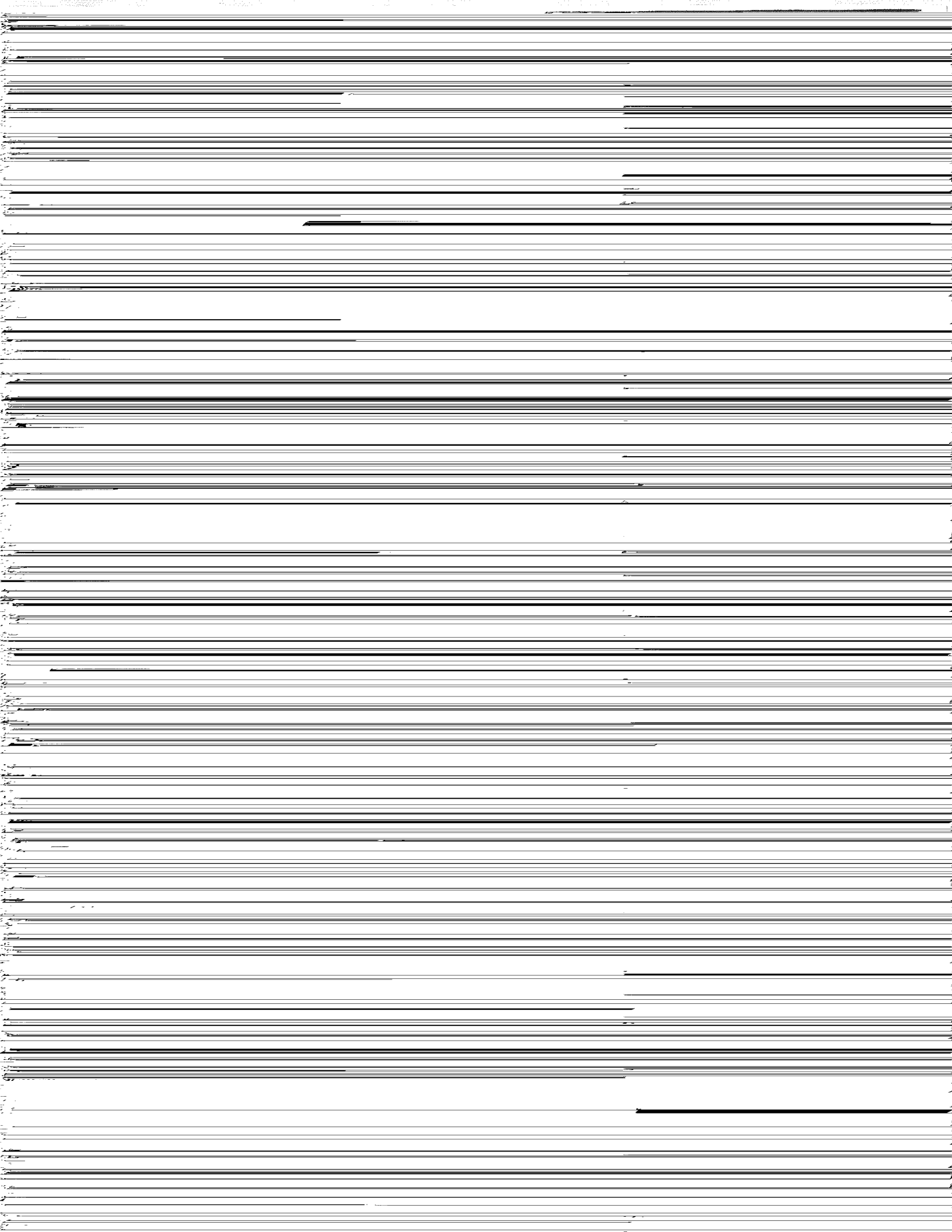

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## LIMITATIONS

A source of possible error within this study was the measurement of literacy orientation by asking parents about their practices and preferences rather than by observing the home environment and parental behaviors in the home. Parents were, however, not told of our interest in literacy, and the questions used to determine CCLO were asked early in the interview, before questions about parental reading, library cards, or books in the home.
